The results after 100,000 cycles show that the volume loss in mm is virtually identical between glazed IPS e.max ${ }^{\circledR}$ and glazed solid zirconia.

While studies typically provide both depth and volume measurements, depth measurements are not considered as accurate as they do not distinguish between a small deep hole versus a wide and shallow hole. Therefore, the volume loss measurement is considered more accurate.


Other studies are ongoing, and as more details emerge we will share them.
